





St Therese of Lisieux, marked
the official launch of this

National Pilgrimage. The pilgrimage will be a special time of grace for all who venerate the relics and a prayerful precursor to the historic convening of Plenary Council 2020.

The relics will arrive at the **Carmelite Monastery** between **3.00—4.00 pm** followed by a Welcoming Ceremony on **Saturday 15th February** and will remain until mid morning on Sunday 16th February. They will then proceed to St Carthage's Cathedral and remain at the Cathedral until Monday morning **17th February**.
