Procedure during COVID-19 Pandemic:

- 1. Only 45 (forty-five) people allowed to attend Mass at one time
- 2. Parishioners will need to ring the Parish Office to **REGISTER** name, address and phone number (DURING OFFICE HOURS ONLY) For Weekend Masses names must be registered by **3.00 pm on the Friday** proceeding the weekend.

## NO ONE CAN JUST TURN UP!

- 3. Parishioners who attend need to **SANITISE** and try to refrain from touching surfaces when finding a place marked **X** to sit
- 4. Parishioners need to sit on and only where the X is marked
- 5. Consideration, please; to be given to **ALL** parishioners so that everyone has a chance to attend a Mass
- 6. At risk parishioners should be exhorted not to attend: authorities have directed that any unwell priest, staff member, volunteer or *parishioners should stay* away; they recommend that people with co-morbidities (e.g. compromised immune or respiratory systems) and those over 70 years of age exercise particular caution; (from Government and Bishop guidelines)
- 7. **Social distancing** is still required according to Government Regulations at least 1.5 metres from each other 4 square metre rule.
- 8. **Only one** entrance **side north door only** Exit for front section of church only from the **south side door and back south door of church**Thank you for your co-operation and consideration
